Borger Country Club Pool Rules

- Swimming prohibited unless a life guard is in attendance.
- All members and guests are required to sign in when entering the pool area.
- Children 12 & under, who are not accompanied by their parents or chaperone, must pass a swimming test.
- Excessive running and playing around the pool is strictly prohibited.
- All swimmers must wear regulation bathing suits. Members, their children, and guests wearing bathing suits must have a cover up on to enter the clubhouse.
- Bottles or glassware of any kind are not allowed in the pool area. No eating or drinking in the change rooms or on the carpeted area except under the awning.
- When there is visible lightning or the sound of thunder, there will be a 30 minute break from swimming. All swimmers must immediately exit the pool and may re-enter when the lifeguards allow.
- All food and beverage must be purchased through the club or snack bar.
- The phone is limited to calls to parents and or children concerning rides. 273.3931
- There is no smoking allowed inside the fenced pool area.
- Food tickets signed by children must include the member's full name.
- Chewing gum will not be allowed in the pool.
- Diving into shallow water is not permitted.
- Divers must go straight off the diving board.
- Children who are not water safe are the absolute responsibility of the parents and will not be allowed in the pool without supervision.
- Chaise lounges and sun lounges are designed to hold only one person at a time, and should be reserved for adults during busy periods.
